EMAC

Effective Management of Anaesthetic Crises

The EMAC course is a three day program consisting of five discrete modules. These are Airway, Anaesthetic Emergencies, Cardiovascular, Human Performance and Trauma. EMAC focuses on the role of the anaesthetist as the team leader during an anaesthetic crisis and the interaction with the staff around the anaesthetist to use their skills and resources effectively.

This course is designed for Anaesthetists and Anaesthetic Registrars who have completed their primary exam and two years of anaesthetic training.

This three day course covers the following topics:

Day 1

- Human performance
- Crisis resource management key points
- Cardiovascular emergencies

Day 2

- Airway emergencies
- Airways skills and drills
- Anaesthetic emergencies
- Bad outcomes

Day 3

- Initial assessment and management of trauma
- C spine, Neurotrauma, Thoracic Trauma and X-Ray
